

Scramble Trips

Online signup tip sheet

Searching / Signing up for upcoming trips:

- Go to www.mountaineers.org (not necessary to log in to search, but is necessary to log in to sign up for a trip)
- Click on **Activity Search** on left
- New screen (“Activity Search”):
 - Note that default is “Basic Search” (top of screen) => recommend clicking on **Advanced Search**
 - Note that the search timeframe defaults to a narrow time window => enter a broader range if desired.
 - For “Activity”, select **Scramble**
 - Note that default is to search for scrambles from *all* Mountaineers branches. You can restrict your search to **Everett** branch if you want. (Recommended – for best getting to know the community and staying actively engaged with the program.)
- New Screen displays search results in chronological order.
 - Click on the **Destination** name to display a trip description
 - Click on **Leader’s name** to get contact info
 - The right-hand column can display a wide variety of info, depending on the trip, such as:
 - “Avail. 6/15” indicates that signup opens 6/15
 - A display of “Main: Avail (4)” indicates signup is open online, and 4 spots remain open. To signup, click on the “Go” button on the left.
 - A display of “Main: Wait List (1)” indicates signup is online, but the trip is full and one person is on the wait list. If you signup on the wait list and a person cancels, you will automatically be bumped up the list by the database.
 - A display of “Signup with Leader” or “Leader’s Permission Required” indicates signup is not online; you need to contact the leader by email / phone to sign up. This indicates that the leader will probably want to query you regarding experience, conditioning, etc.

Searching for past Trip Reports to research a destination:

Mountaineers.org website:

Does not have many trip reports loaded in system yet, but is getting populated with new trip reports rapidly.

- Go to www.mountaineers.org > Activity Search
- Under the timeframe boxes check “Search for past activity reports”

EverettMountaineers.org website:

Has many past trip reports, but is no longer being populated, so does not have any fresh reports.

- Go to www.everettmountaineers.org > Alpine Scrambling > Trip Reports
