Driving Instructions: **HW2 to Baring General Store; Left across tracks and up FS 6024 to end**

Ascent Route: **Took old spur road to right of Barclay Cr Trail < 1 mile to stream and up stream then dry gully to ridge @ 4,000' Ran ridge east on scramble trail and at 4,200 headed up to basin, near due east on right hand side of large rock formation. Crossed basin on boulders and hit two small patches of snow up in gully to V cut. Scrambled to left from cut through trees and boulder fields and summited from SW**

Descent Route: **Same in reverse plus got some glisading in on the short snow patches**
