Trip Narrative / Comments: A HARD 3200' ASCENT, ALMOST ALL ELEVATION GAIN OFF TRAIL, THIS PEAK HAS EVERYTHING: BOULDER HOPPING IN CANYON BOTTOM, COMPLEX ROUTE FINDING TO RIDGE, HUGE EXPOSED SLABS, HEAVY BRUSH, CLASS 4 DOWN CLIMBING IN AN EXPOSED COL, STEEP EXPOSED ROCKY UPPER SLOPES. A SELDOM VISITED PEAK, ALL PARTY MEMBERS SUFFERED MINOR SCRATCHES, BRUISES, BASHED KNEES, ETC.
