

### Trip Report

Little Annapurna/East Dragontail            Rock            Elev. 8850'  
Sept. 11, 1990                            3.75 Mi. R.T.            Gain 1050'

The approach to Aesgard Pass is 6.0 miles in and 4400' of elevation gain. The scramble started at Aesgard Pass at 8:30 AM. Descended off of Aesgrad Pass between two lakes and ascended a ridge to a knoll N.W. of Little Annapurna (LA). From the lakes good slab type rocks were climbed to ascend to the knoll. Descended off the knoll and climbed to the summit of LA to the S.E. From LA descended gradually to N.W. to pass between LA and East Dragontail (East DT). Proceeded WNW 500 yds. between two black rock out croppings at ridge line of East DT. Located a slanting ledge up and to the left then climbed to the ridge line of East DT. then followed the ridge line to the summit of East DT. Descended the same route off of East DT to the pass between LA and East DT then descended to the lakes and back up to Aesgard Pass, arrived at 3:30PM. No problems encountered. The rock was good climbing to get experience on varying angles of slab type rock. All the party members were very comfortable on the type of rock encountered.
