

Kitling Pk (8003') by Easy Pass, I went up this on 10/6-7 of 1988. A crumbling rotten scree peak, but it has wonderful views, especially of Mt Logan. Lots of side hill scree traversing. I found it easier to traverse fairly low as the footing was a bit better. Peak would be a R2 or maybe R3 scramble. The route takes the trail up to Easy Pass, then traverse upward on the west side of the ridge until you're below Kitling Pk. The ascent to the summit is not difficult. The hardest part was the side hill scree slopes leading to the peak. Water could be a problem as there is no dependable water source after Easy Pass, where you aren't allowed to camp. The first snow of the year had hit when I did it so I had new snow for water. Despite all the scree, I found this a very rewarding peak.
