TRIP NARRATION: ORIGINAL DESTINATION WAS DENNY MTN., BUT WAS CHANGED TO LITTLE SI, DUE TO BLASTING ON DENNY MTA. WEATHER WAS NICE, WARM & SUNNY. THIS WAS A SHORT ROCK SCRAMBLE WITH A SHORT APPROACH (1 1/2 MILES). ALTHOUGH WEATHER WAS WARM & SUNNY, ROCK WAS GENERALLY WET AND SLICK. THE S.E. "SCRAMBLE ROUTE" WOULD BE A GOOD ROCK SCRAMBLE YEAR ROUND, AS THIS ELEVATION RARELY HAS SNOW. WE FIRST MET AT ALPENTAL PARKING LOT AT 8:15, BUT ENDED UP GOING CONTINUE ON BACK IF NECESSARY

BACK TO NORTH BEACH, AND PARKING JUST ACROSS THE
SNOQUAWNE RIVER BRIDGE, IN A SMALL PARKING AREA
NEXT TO THE BRIDGE. WE STARTED HIKING FROM HERE
AT 9:30. EVERYONE ENJOYED THE GOOD WEATHER &
HAD A GOOD TIME. WE DESCENDED VIA THE "HIKING
ROUTE" WHICH COMES DOWN THE NORTHWEST SIDE
OF LITTLE SI, AND THEN CIRCLES ON AROUND THE
NORTH, NE, AND EAST SIDES AND MEETS BACK
UP WITH THE "SCRAMBLE ROUTE" ON THE S.E. SIDE.
