At the end of the Emmons Glacier Overlook Trail, a trail continues through some overgrown brush and small trees to the edge of mature forest. An abandoned road with many fallen trees across it may then be followed. Turning somewhat southerly, and gaining approx. 500' about 2/3rds of a mile up this road, you will come upon large alpine meadows. Follow meadows to western edge, then S up to ridge. Follow ridge to summit.
